As part of the Legal Charter, law firms are required to complete the SRA Diversity Questionnaire.

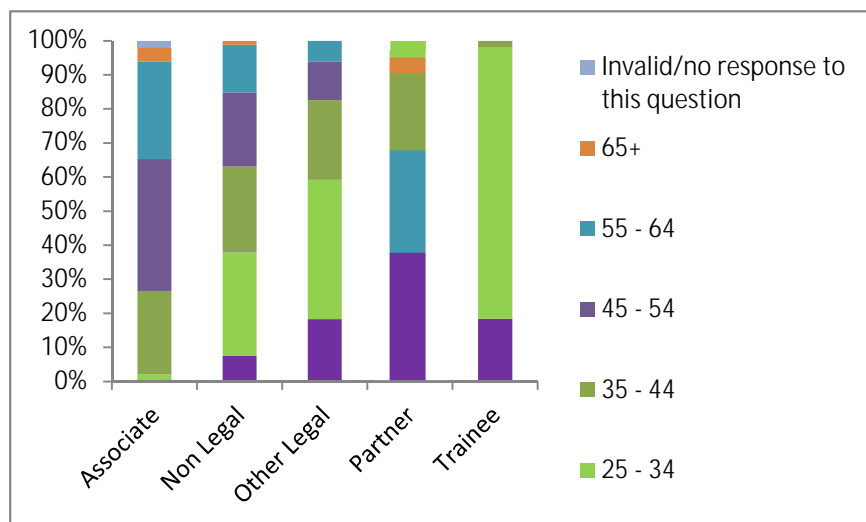
This document will set out our findings from this year’s questionnaire.

769 Clyde & Co employees responded to the SRA diversity questionnaire for 2019.

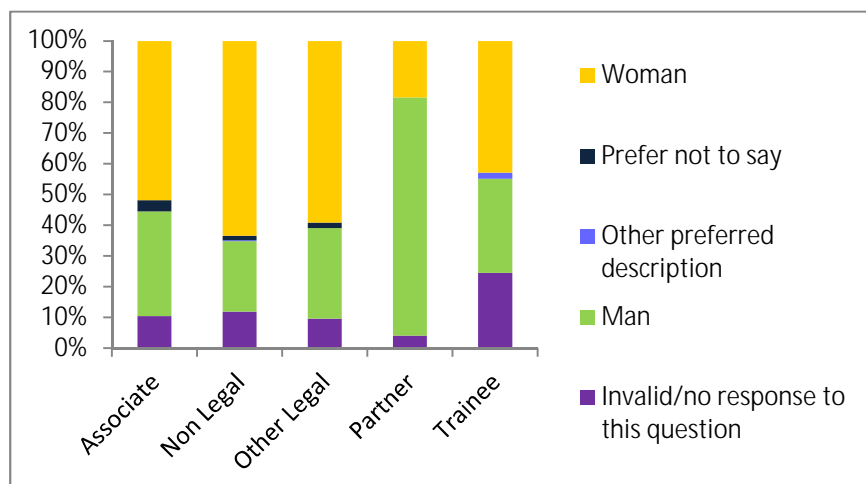

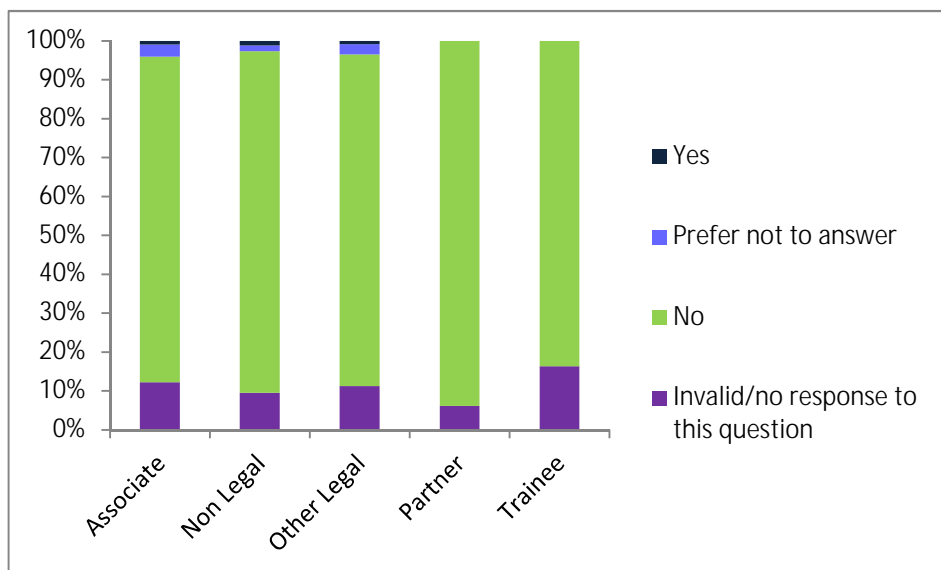

Which gender do you identify with?



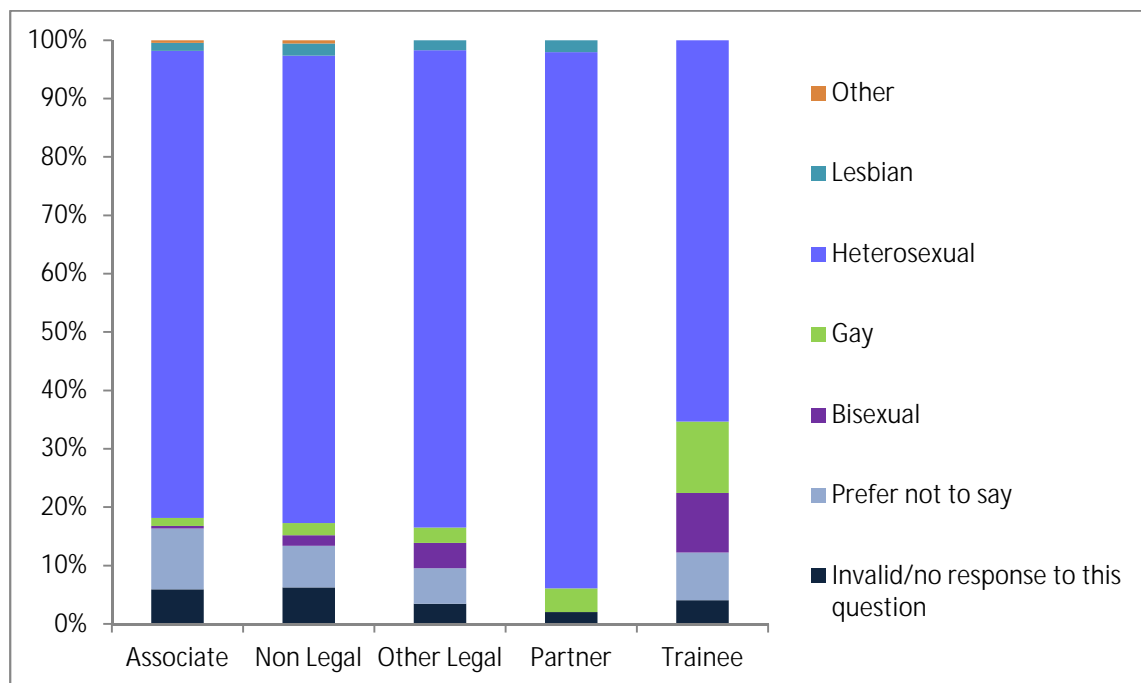

What is your sexual orientation?



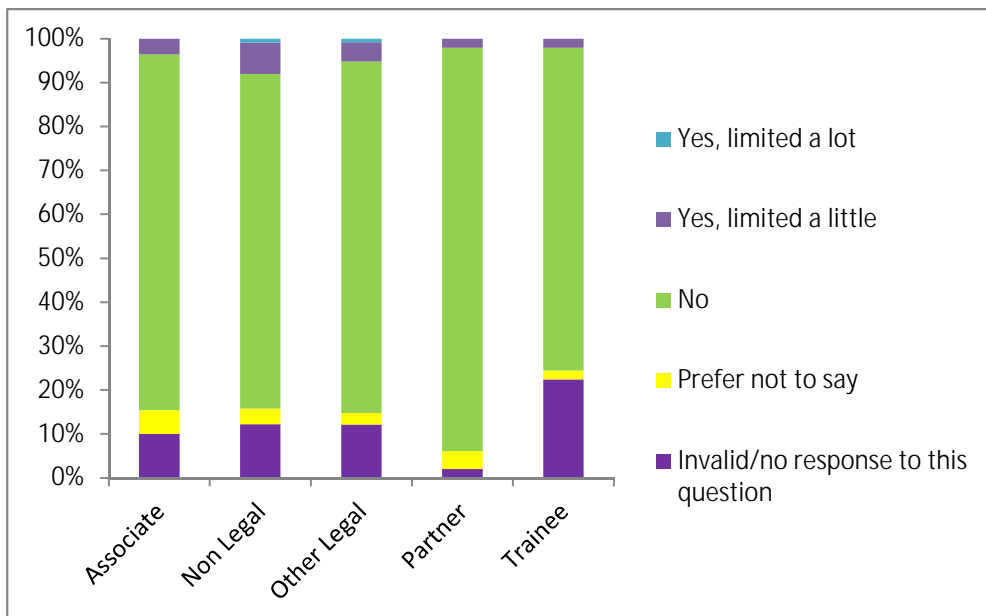

Do you consider yourself to have a disability?



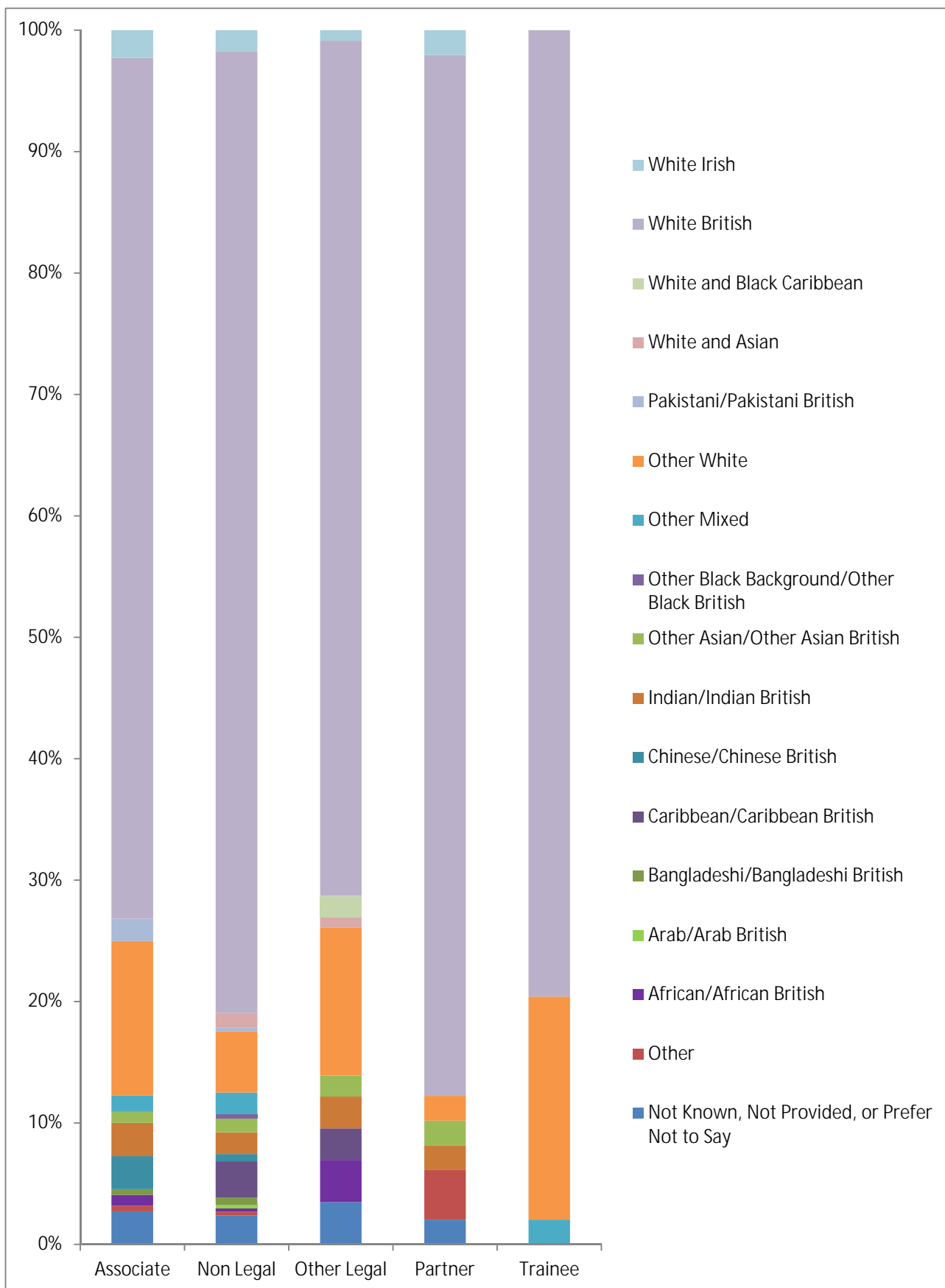

Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?



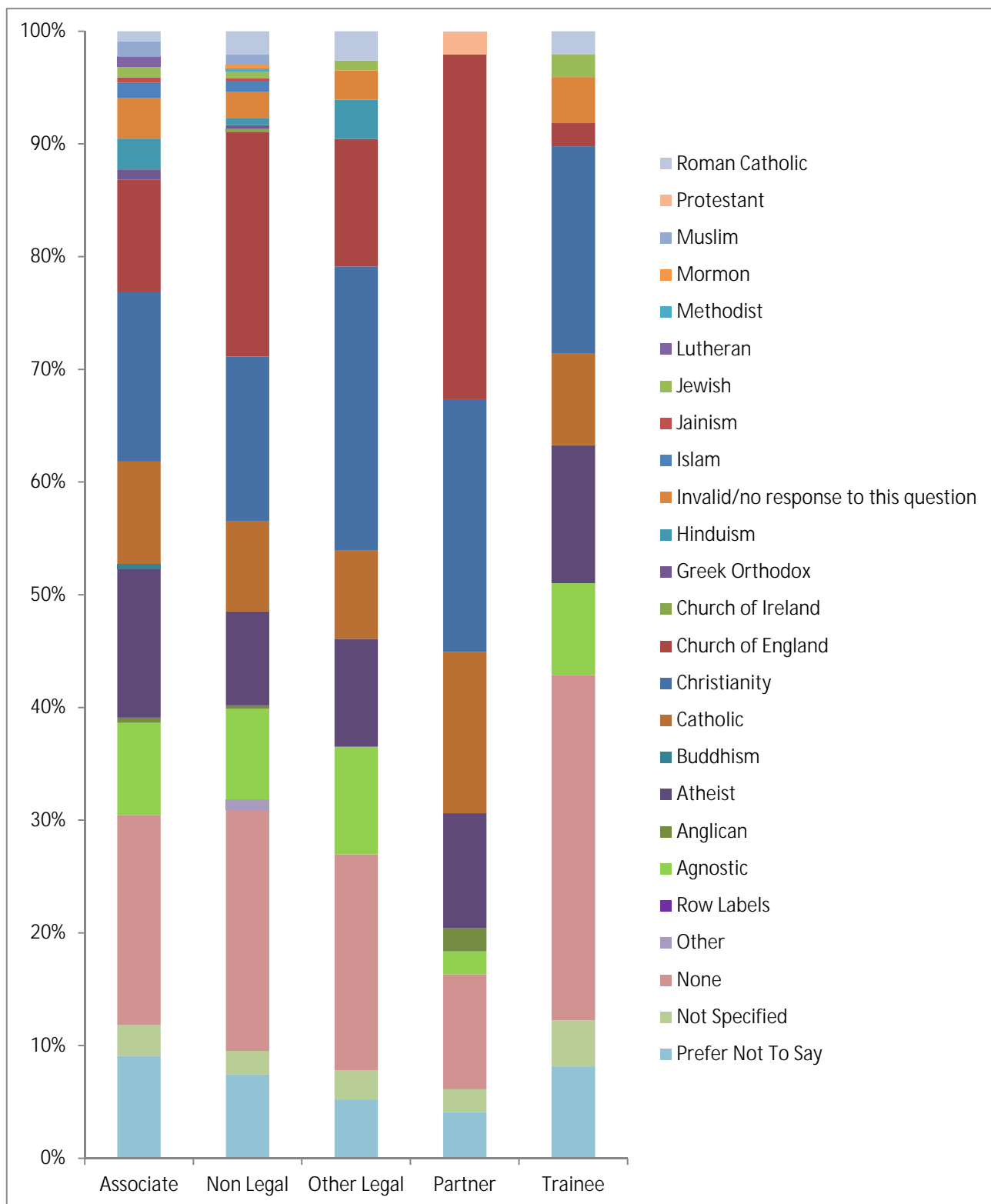

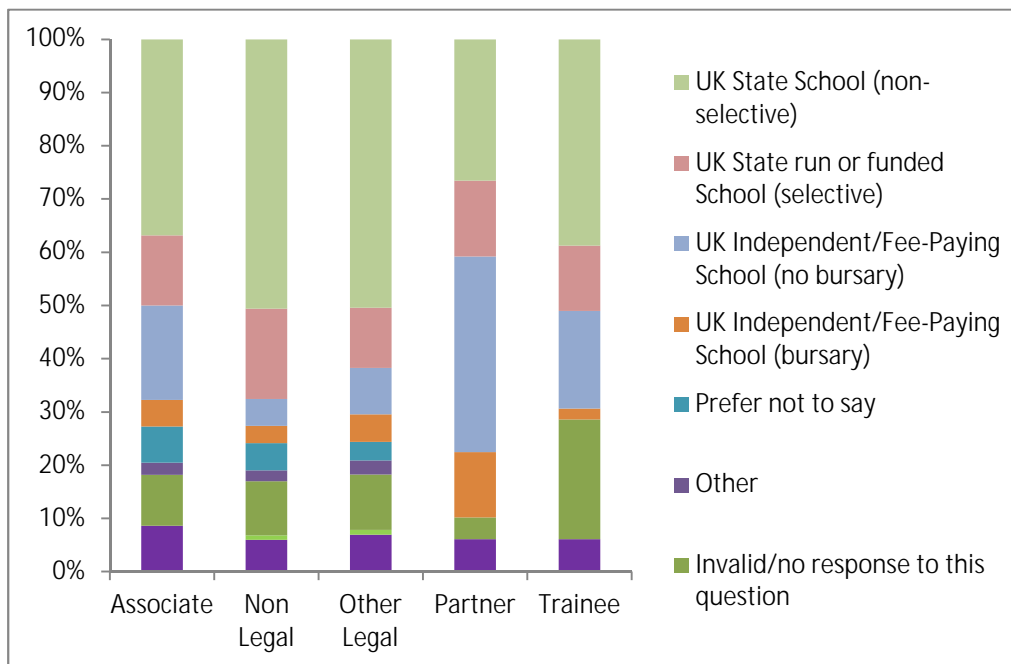

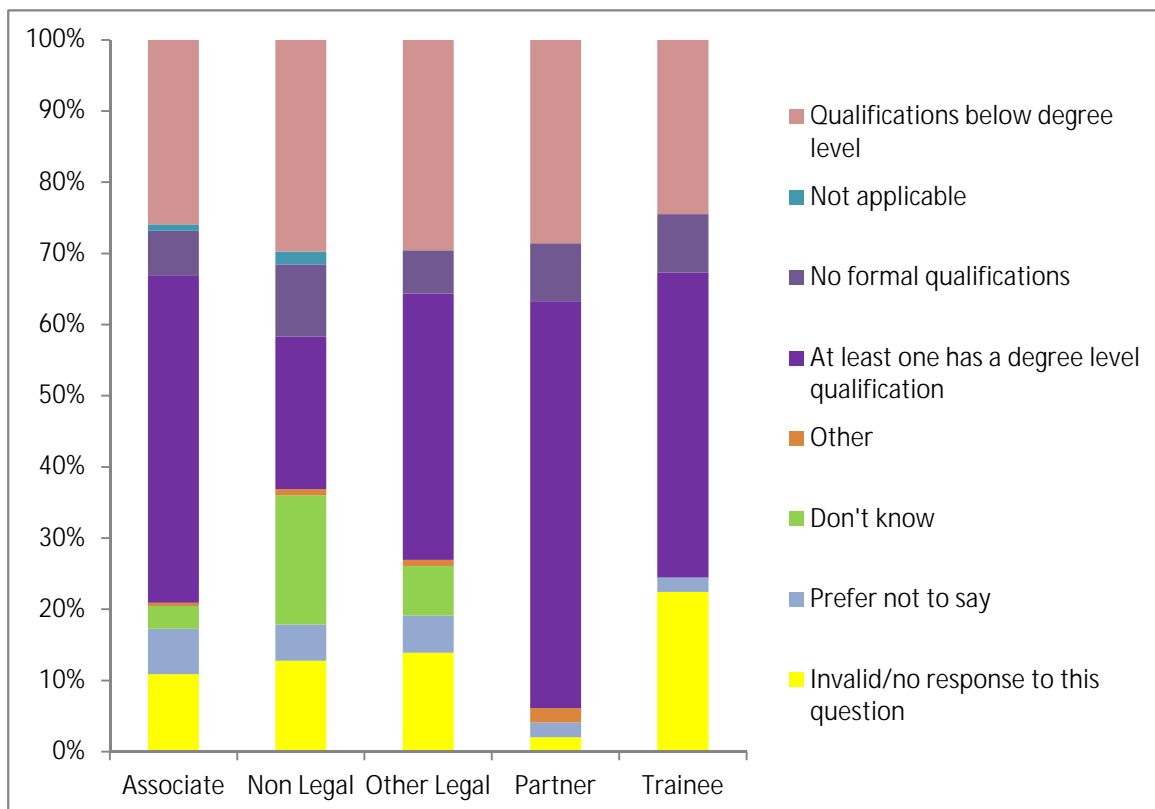

What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages 11 and 16?



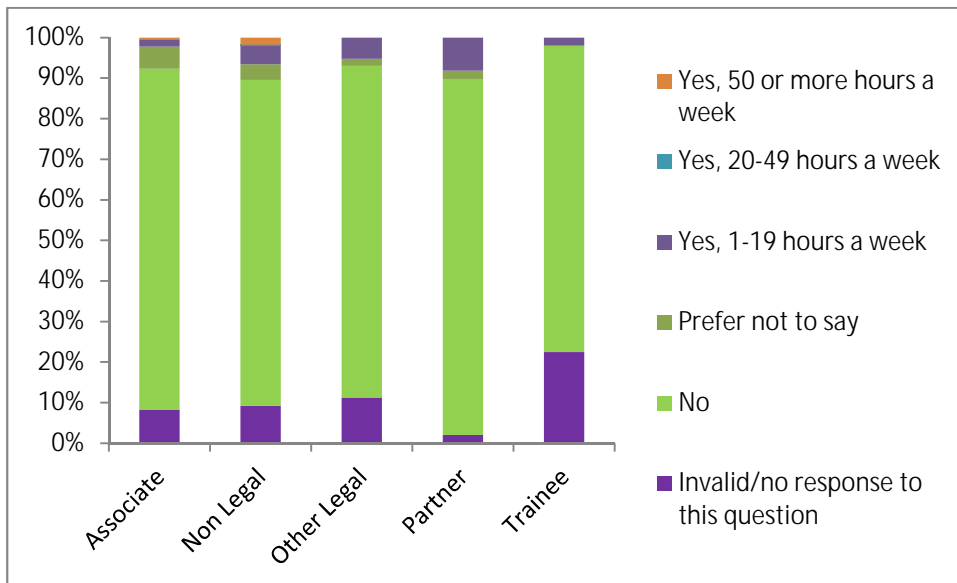
